

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 156-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 4-79, BEING  
A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 144-77, BEING A BY-LAW  
TO DESIGNATE AN IMPROVEMENT AREA TO BE KNOWN  
AS THE DOWNTOWN IMPROVEMENT AREA AND TO ESTABLISH  
A BOARD OF MANAGEMENT THEREOF.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay declares by resolution that the Progressive Business Guild is no longer representative of those persons and corporations assessed for business assessment in respect of lands in the Downtown Improvement Area and deems it advisable to amend By-law 4-79,


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Clause 1 of By-law 4-79 shall be amended by deleting the last three lines of Clause 1 therefrom and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
"who are not members of the Municipal Council shall be appointed as follows: three members from a list of not fewer than six persons to be nominated by the Progressive Business Guild and two members at large from the Downtown Improvement Area."
2. This by-law shall come into force upon the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1982.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 7th DAY OF September 1982.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 7th DAY OF September , 1982.
