# By-Law No. 2014-69

### Being A By-Law to Provide for Advance Votes to be Held Prior to Voting Day and to Provide for Reduced Hours of Voting in Institutions and Retirement Homes

**Whereas** Section 43.(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act,* S.O. 1996, as amended, provides that a municipal council shall pass a by-law establishing one or more dates for an advance vote, and the hours during which voting places shall be open on that date or dates;

**And Whereas** Section 43.(2) of the *Municipal Elections Act,* S.O. 1996, as amended, provides that a municipal council shall pass a by-law with reduced hours in voting places in retirement homes or those institutions as defined in Section 45.(7) of the said Act, where the voting place is only for the use of the residents;

**And Whereas** by Resolution No. 2014-222 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting on Monday, May 12, 2014 Council authorized a by-law to provide for advance votes to be held prior to Voting Day and to provide for reduced hours of voting in Institutions and Retirement Homes;

# Now Therefore, the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Advance votes for the 2014 Municipal Elections shall be held at the locations and dates and times shown on Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- 2. Those voting places in Institutions and Retirement Homes as shown in Schedule "B" attached hereto shall be open for those hours as also detailed in Schedule "B".

Read a First Time in Open Council this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2014.

Read a Second Time in Open Council this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2014.

Read a Third Time in Open Council and Enacted and Passed this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2014.
