BY-LAW NO. 62-86

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC BY-LAW NO. 2-82 (SCHEDULE 9 - STOP SIGNS: SCHEDULE 8 - DESIGNATED THROUGH HIGHWAYS AND SCHEDULE 2 - NO PARKING AREAS)

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 198 as amended authorizes the Council to pass by-laws regulating traffic on highways;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That Schedule 9 to Traffic By-Law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by adding the following Schedule 9 to be in force and effect until August 1, 1986:
  - (4) Princess St. and Fraser St. on all four approaches
- 2. That Schedule 8 to Traffic By-Law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by deleting the following from Section "F":

Road From <u>To</u> 15. Fraser Street Victoria Street Chippewa Street

3. That Schedule 8 to Traffic By-Law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by adding the following to Section "F" to come into force and effect on August 1, 1986:

Road	From	To
15. Fraser Street	Princess Street	Chippewa Street

4. That Schedule 8 to Traffic By-Law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by adding the following to Section "P" to come into force and effect on August 1, 1986:

RoadFromToll. Princess StreetFerguson StreetCassells Street

5. That Schedule 2 to Traffic By-Law No. 2-82 is hereby amended by deleting the following from Section "O":

5.	Oak Street	South	90 metres east of Ferguson Street to Wyld Street

6. That Schedule 2 to Traffic By-Law No. 2-82 be amended by adding the following to Section "D":

Road	Side	Between
5. Oak Street	South	Ferguson Street to Wyld Street
