BY-LAW NO. 1698

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to close a portion of Stevens Street in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to close a portion of Stevens Street in the City of North Bay, said portion of Stevens Street being bounded on the north by McIntyre Street and on the south by Harriet Street.

THEREFORE under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay by the Municipal Act, R. S. O., 1950 Chapter 243, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT a portion of Stevens Street in the City of North Bay, described as follows: Commencing at a point in the westerly limit of Stevens Street where said limit is intersected by the northerly limit of Harriet Street, thence northerly along the westerly limit of Stevens Street five hundred and forty feet (540') more or less to a point where said westerly limit of Stevens Street is intersected by the southerly limit of McIntyre Street, thence in an easterly direction sixty-six feet (66') more or less to the southeasterly angle of Stevens and McIntyre Street, thence southerly along the easterly limit of Stevens Street five hundred and forty feet more or less to a point where said easterly limit of Stevens Street is intersected by the northerly limit of Harriet Street, thence westerly a distance of sixty-six feet (66') more or less to the point of commencement, as shown on registered plan No. 15. IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.
2. THAT the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent any person who claims that his land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applies to be heard.
3. THAT this By-Law shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the Municipal Act.
