

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 191-88

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF
LANDS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR MUNICIPAL
PURPOSES. (CLAUDIO, SISCA, TOFFOLON)

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, Section 193 authorizes the Council to pass by-laws to sell lands no longer required for municipal purposes.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to Joseph Claudio, Antonio Sisca and Guiliano Toffolon, their successors, heirs and assigns, that portion of land described as "Secondly" in Parcel 8650 W&F and all of Parcel 6382 W&F required as a property addition for the sum of Thirty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$34,700.00) plus legal, survey and appraisal fees.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a transfer of the said lands in favour of Joseph Claudio, Antonio Sisca and Guiliano Toffolon, their successors, heirs and assigns and such further and other documents as may be reasonably be required to complete the said Transfer.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 28TH DAY OF NOVEMBER 1988.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 12TH DAY OF DECEMBER 1988.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 12TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1988.
