BY LAW # 860.

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize the borrowing of Fifteen Thousand Dollars.

WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow for the purpose of purchasing certain lands and premises in the City of North Bay, known as Amelia Park, for Park purposes, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), and that is the amount of the debt intended to be created.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the whole rateable property of the Municipality according to the last Revised Assessment Roll is \$8,440,037.00.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the Debenture debt of the Corporation, exclusive of Local Improvement Rates is \$1,600.832.53, no part of the principal or interest of which is in arrears.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUN/ICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. THE property referred to in the preamble is set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached, and forms part of this By-Law.
- FOR the purpose mentioned in the preamble there shall be borrowed on the credit of the corporation the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) and debentures shall be issued therefor in sums of not less than One Hundred Dollars each, which shall have coupons attached thereto for the payment of the interest.
- 3. THE Debentures shall all bear the same date and shall be issued within one year after the date on which this By-Law is passed, and may bear any date within such year and shall be payable within twenty years from the date when they shall be issued, and shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum, payable yearly in twenty annual instalments during the twenty years next after the date which they shall be issued, and the respectife amounts payable in each of such years shall be as set forth in Schedule "B" hereto attached.
- 4. THE Debentures as to both principal and interest may be expressed in Canadian Currency, and shall be payable at the Royal Bank of Canada, North Bay, Ontario.
- 5. THE Mayor of the Corporation shall sign and issue the Debentures and the Debentures and interest coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer and the Debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation. The signature of the Treasurer upon the Coupons may be written, stamped, lithographed, or engraved.
- 6. DURING the currency of the Debentures there shall be raised in each year the amount of the instalment of principal and interest, payable in that year, as set forth in Schedule "B" hereto attached.
- 7. THE debentures may contain any provision for the registration of them authorized by law.
