BEING A BY-LAW of the Town of North Bay to amend  
By-law Number Six Hundred and Twenty-Five of the Town of  
North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay  
deem it advisable to amend By-law Number Six Hundred and Twenty-  
Five of the said Town of North Bay.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of North  
Bay enacts as follows :-

1. THAT Section 10. of the said By-law be amended by  
adding the following clause as Section 10 A thereto;

"THAT no vehicle shall turn at the intersection of  
Main Street and Klock Avenue, excepting only from Main Street  
to Klock Avenue, or from Klock Avenue to Main Street and that  
there be no Silent Policeman at this intersection in the said  
Town of North Bay!"

2. THAT clause 12 of the said By-law be repealed and  
that the following clause <sup>be</sup> substituted there for;

"THAT a vehicle shall not stop or obstruct crossings  
within the Town of North Bay, and shall reduce its speed to a  
safe limit at crossings and shall not exceed the speed of  
twenty miles an hour within the limits of the Town of North Bay.

3. THAT Clause 13 of the said By-law is hereby repealed  
and the following clause substituted there for;

"THAT no motor vehicle shall be premitted to remain  
standing or parked on Main Street between Foran Street and  
Sherbrooke Street in the Town of North Bay for a longer period  
than thirty minutes, at any one time and any day of the week"
