

BY-LAW NO. 1310

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1309 which is a By-Law to levy the Taxes for the year 1939 and to provide for the collection thereof.

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to amend said By-Law No. 1309.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY enacts as follows:

1. THAT Clause No. 1 of said By-Law No. 1309 be and the same is hereby deleted from said By-Law No. 1309 and the following Clause is hereby substituted in lieu thereof:

"FOR the purpose of providing the sum of \$595,766.00 for the general purposes of the Corporation, including the amount required for Public, Separate, Collegiate and Vocational Schools, Public Library, Direct Relief and other purposes for the current year, there shall be levied and collected a rate of 61.5 mills in the dollar upon the whole rateable property of the Public School Supporters of the City of North Bay according to the last revised Assessment Roll, which rate is made up as follows:

General Rate .....	34. Mills
being 35.5 Mills less 1½ Mills deduction as provided by the Ontario Government Subsidy	
Collegiate & Vocational School Rate .....	9. Mills
Public School Rate .....	14.5 Mills
Direct Relief .....	4. Mills

and there shall be levied and collected during the said year a rate of 67.5 Mills in the dollar upon the whole rateable property of the Separate School Supporters of the City of North Bay, according to the last revised Assessment Roll, which rate is made up as follows:

General Rate .....	34. Mills
being 35.5 Mills less 1½ Mills deduction as provided by the Ontario Government Subsidy	
Collegiate & Vocational School Rate .....	9. Mills
Separate School Rate .....	20.5 Mills
Direct Relief .....	4. Mills

READ a Second Time in Open Council this 6th. day of April, 1939.
