BY-LAW NO. 1902.

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to authorize the sale by the City to Louis Berger and/or adjoining owners entitled thereto of certain streets, Avenues and Lanes, closed byBy-law 1901 at a price of not less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per acre.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. That the Elks Club be given the opportunity
 - (i) of purchasing that portion of Cassells Street adjoining its lands in accordance with statutory provisions and at a price of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per acre.
 - (ii) that the remainder of the said Streets, Avenues and lanes or the whole of same if the Elks Club declines to purchase, be sold to Louis Berger at the rate of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per acre.
