## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 29-68

BEING A BY-LAW REQUIRING THE CLOSING OF CERTAIN CLASSES OF SHOPS IN THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS, The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1960, Chapter 249, Section 379(a), as amended, authorizes the Council to pass by-laws for the purposes therein stated;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to enact the within By-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In this By-law "Holiday" shall mean:
  - (i) New Year's Day, Good Friday, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, the birthday or the day fixed by proclamation of the Governor General for the celebration of the birthday of the reigning Sovereign, Victoria Day, Dominion Day, Labour Day, Sunday and any day appointed by proclamation of the Governor General or the Lieutenant Governor as a public holiday or for a general fast or thanksgiving, and when any holiday, except Remembrance Day, falls on a Sunday, the day next following is in lieu thereof a holiday;
  - (ii) Any day proclaimed by the Head of the Council as a Civic holiday.
- 2. Section 3 of this By-law shall not apply to any of the following classes of shops:
  - (a)
  - Barber Shop; Beauty Parlour; (b)
  - Shoe Shine Shop; (c)
  - Shoe Repair Shop; (d)
  - Hat Cleaning and blocking business; (e)
  - (f) Shop for the retail sale of fresh fruit and fresh vegetables;
  - Retail Drug Store Shop; (g)
  - (h) Retail Gasoline Service Station;
  - Retail Gasoline Pump and Outlet; (i)
  - Shop for the Retail Sale of Motor Vehicles; (j)
  - Retail Tobacco Shop; (k)
  - Retail Tobacco and Confectionery Shop; (1)
  - (m) Retail Boat and Marine Supply Shop;
  - Shop for the Retail Sale of Dairy or Milk Products, (n) including a Dairy Bar;
  - (o) Retail Delicatessen Shop;
  - (p) Retail Builder Supplies Shop;
  - (q)
  - Retail Hobby Shop; Retail Florist Shop; (r)
- During the whole of each year, and subject as hereinafter pro-3• vided, all classes of shops within the City of North shall be closed:
- (a) on Tuesday, Wednesday and Saturday of each week at six o'clock in the afternoon of each of such days, and shall remain closed until five o'clock in the forenoon of the day next following each of such days;

(b) on Thursday and Friday of each week at ten o'clock in the afternoon of each of such days, and shall remain closed until five o'clock in the forenoon of the day next following each of such days;



- on Monday of each week during the whole of such day, and shall remain closed until five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day except those Mondays included within the period extending from the 15th day of June totthe 31st day of August, both dates inclusive, in each year, and except those Mondays included within the period extending from the 1st day of December to the 24th day of December, both dates inclusive in each year;
- (d) on each of the twelve days, exclusive of Sundays, immediately preceding the 25th day of December, in each year, at ten o'clock in the afternoon of each of such days, and shall remain closed until five o'clock in the forenoon of the day next following each of such days;
- (e) on each boliday, and shall remain closed throughout the whole of such day until five o'clock in the forenoon of the next following day;
- (f) on the two days, exclusive of Sunday, immediately preceding New Year's Day, Dominion Day and Good Friday, at ten o'clock in the afternoon of each of such days, and shall remain closed until five o'clock in the forenoon of the day next following each of such days.
- 4. So long as the time commonly observed in the City of North Bay is one hour in advance of standard time, the times mentioned in Section 379 (a) of the aforesaid Act, as amended and in this By-law, shall be reckoned in accordance with the time so commonly observed and not standard time.
- 5. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate, a fine or penalty not exceeding the sum of \$2,000.00 for each offence, exclusive of costs, to be recoverable under The Summary Convictions Act.
- 6. By-laws Nos. 1294, 1970, 1979, 1985, 2034, 2063, and 2366 of the City of North Bay, shall be deemed to be and they are hereby repealed.
- 7. This By-law shall take effect on the 1st day of May, 1968 and shall be published once in The Nugget, a daily newspaper published in the City of North Bay, on the 27th day of April, 1968.
