

BY-LAW 1875

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize construction of storm sewers in the City of North Bay.


WHEREAS the construction of storm sewers to be authorized under this By-law are essential to the Segregation Programme of storm and sanitary sewage because of the establishment of a sewage treatment plant by the Ontario Water Resources Commission.


THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY under the provisions of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1950, Chapter 243, Section 386, Sub-section 12, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That storm sewers be constructed on the streets described in Schedule "A" which schedule is attached hereto and forms part of this by-law.
2. That the Engineering Department of the City of North Bay be instructed to make all necessary plans, profiles and specifications forthwith, and to furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work, or for the carrying on of the work by day labour.
3. That the work shall be carried on under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of the Engineering Department of the City of North Bay.
4. That the Council may decide by resolutions to carry on and execute the work by day labour.
5. That in the absence of a resolution by Council the work be carried on and executed by day labour, the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with some person or persons, firm or Corporation for the construction of the work, subject to the approval of the Council by resolution.
6. That the Treasurer may, subject to approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending completion of such work.
7. That debentures to be issued when the work is completed to pay for the cost of such work, shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine, and shall be made payable within fifteen years on the instalment plan.
8. That this by-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 67, Sub-section 1, of the Ontario Municipal Board Act (R.S.O. 1950, Chapter 262.)



BY-LAW 1875

- 215 lin.ft. of 48-inch storm sewer in lane from Chippewa Creek to Wyld Street.
- 142 lin.ft. of 48-inch storm sewer on Wyld Street from lane to Chippewa Street.
- 1440 lin.ft. of 48-inch storm sewer along Chippewa Street from Wyld Street to Fraser Street.
- 325 lin.ft. of 48-inch storm sewer on Fraser Street from Chippewa Street to Duke Street.
- 310 lin.ft. of 42-inch storm sewer on Fraser Street from Duke Street to Princess Street.
- 329 lin.ft. of 39-inch storm sewer on Fraser Street from Princess Street to Victoria Street.
- 349 lin.ft. of 21-inch storm sewer on Fraser Street from Victoria Street to King Street.
- 390 lin.ft. of 12-inch storm sewer on King Street from Fraser Street 390 feet southerly.
- 800 lin.ft. of 33-inch storm sewer on Victoria Street from Fraser Street to Ferguson Street.
- 585 lin.ft. of 18-inch storm sewer on King Street from Fraser Street to Cassells Street.
- 281 lin.ft. of 24-inch storm sewer on Ferguson Street from Victoria Street to King Street.

Total \$ 113,500.00

The above cost has been reduced by the estimated amount of subsidy due from the Federal-Provincial winter aid programme.

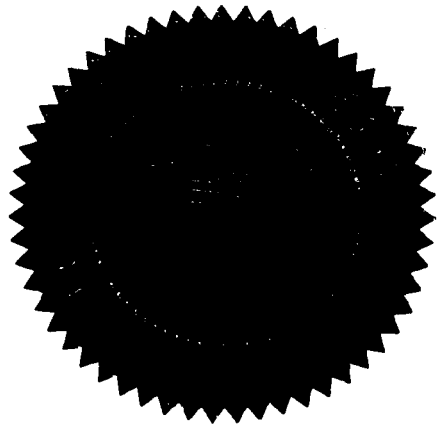

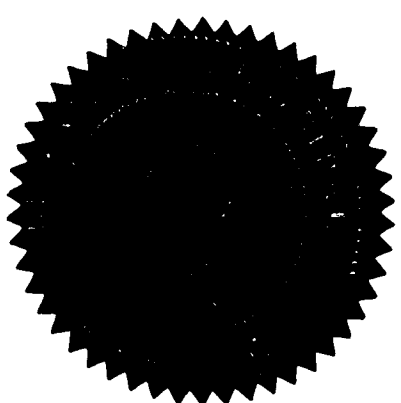

9. On Victoria Street from Fraser Street to Ferguson Street.
10. On King Street from Fraser Street to Cassells Street.
11. On Ferguson Street from Victoria Street to King Street.
