

BY-LAW NO. 1242

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1198 which is a By-Law providing for the licensing and regulating of Dogs in the Corporation of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to amend By-Law No. 1198.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED that By-Law No. 1198 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay be amended as follows:

1. THAT any person desirous of having their dog or dogs destroyed by the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall pay to the Treasurer of the said Corporation the sum of One Dollar and Fifth Cents (\$1.50) for the destroying of each dog and removing same to the City Dump. Said fee to be paid before such dog is destroyed.

2. THAT Clause No. 10 of By-Law No. 1198 be amended by striking out the words "within four full days" in line five and the words "within four days" in line fifteen and substituting therefore the following words "Within four full days if the dog is wearing a Tag of the current year and within forty-eight hours if the dog is not wearing such tag."

3. THAT Clause No. 10 of By-Law No. 1198 be further amended by striking out the words "after four clear days from such impounding" and substituting therefore the word "immediately."

READ a First Time in Open Council this 18th. day of May, 1936.

READ a Second Time in Open Council this 15th. day of June, 1936.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law read a Third Time short and Passed this 15th. day of June. 1936.
