

A BY-LAW to provide for the submission of a certain by-law for the assent of the electors of the City of North Bay and to appoint a date on which to take a vote thereon and to name the places where the votes are to be taken and to appoint Deputy Returning Officers to take the vote at every such place.

WHEREAS the said Council deems it advisable to submit to the vote of the electors of the Corporation of the City of North Bay the proposed by-law of the Corporation which is entitled "A By-Law to authorize the Corporation of the City of North Bay to enter into an agreement with John Palangio of the City of North Bay carrying on business under the firm name and style of DELUXE TRANSPORTATION COMPANY."

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT there shall be submitted to the electors of the City of North Bay a proposed by-law entitled "A By-Law to authorize the corporation of the City of North Bay to enter into an agreement with John Palangio of the City of North Bay carrying on business under the firm name and style of DELUXE TRANSPORTATION COMPANY."
2. THAT the votes of the said electors shall be taken on the said By-Law at the same time and places and by Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks at the annual Municipal Elections.
3. A True copy of the by-law shall be published in the North Bay Nugget on the days hereinafter mentioned, that is to say;

November 5th, 1947
November 12th, 1947
November 19th, 1947

4. ON the second day of December, 1947 at his office in the Council Chambers on Ferguson Street in the City of North Bay at two o'clock in the afternoon, the Mayor will in writing signed by him appoint two persons to attend the Final Summing up of the votes by the Clerk of this Corporation and one person to attend each Polling Place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the proposed by-law and a like number on behalf of the persons interest in and desirous of opposing the proposed by-law.

6. the tenth day of December at the said Council Chamber at twelve o'clock in the forenoon is hereby appointed as the time and place for summing up, by the Clerk of this Corporation of the number of votes given in the affirmative and in the negative, respectively.
