## BY-LAW NUMBER 914.

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 798 as amended by By-law No. 802 referring to the licensing and regulating all victualling houses, ordinaries, and houses where fruit, fish, oysters, clams or victuals are sold to be eaten therein, and places not being a tavern or shop licensed under the Liquor License Act for the lodging refreshment or entertainment of the public.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable that By-law No. 798 as amended by By-law No. 802 be further amended in connection with the licensing and regulating all victualling houses, ordinaries, and houses where fruit, fish, oysters, clams or victuals are sold to be eaten therein, and places not being a tavern or shop licensed under the liquor License Act, for lodging, reception, refreshment or entertainment of the public.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That enacting Clause No. 2 By-law No. 798 be amended by striking out the words and figures One Dollar (\$1.00) and inserting in lieu thereof, the words and figures Five (\$5.00) Dollars.
- 2. That enacting Clause No. 5 be amended by striking out the words and figures One Dollar (\$1.00) in the fourth and fifth lines and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures Five Dollars (\$5.00).
