

BY-LAW NUMBER 682.

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for taking the votes of the Electors on the following question:-

"Are you in favour of the adoption of the Act cited, the Public Parks Act, being Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1914, Chapter 203, and Amendments thereto, being adopted for the Corporation of the Town of North Bay ?"

WHEREAS it is considered desirable and expedient to obtain the opinion of the Electors on the following question :-

"Are you in favour of the adoption of the Act cited, the Public Parks Act, being revised Statutes of Ontario, 1914, Chapter 203, and Amendments thereto, being adopted for the Corporation of the Town of North Bay ?"

And to pass this By-Law for the purpose of enabling the Electors to vote on said question :

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS :-

1. The votes of the electors of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay, shall be taken upon the said proposed By-Law at the same time and at the same places as the annual election for the Municipal Council, and the Deputing Returning Officers appointed to hold said election shall take the vote.
2. On the 31st day of December, A. D. 1923, at the hour of Two o'clock in the afternoon, the head of the Council of the said Corporation or some member of said Council appointed for that purpose by resolution, shall attend at The Council Chamber, in the said Municipality, for the purpose of appointing, and, if requested so to do, shall appoint by writing signed by him, two persons to attend at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk, and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and voting in the affirmative on said question, and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and voting in the negative on said question.
3. On the 8th day of January, A. D. 1924 at the hour of ten o'clock in the fore-noon, at the Town Hall, in the said Municipality, the Clerk of the said Municipality shall attend and sum up the votes given in the affirmative and negative on the said question.
