

CONSTRUCTION BY-LAW NUMBER 895.

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize the construction of Sanitary Sewers on certain streets in the City of North Bay as a local improvement under the Provisions of the Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS R. Calvello and others have petitioned the Council to construct as local improvements the works hereinafter described and the Clerk has certified that the petitions are sufficient and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitions in the manner hereinafter provided.

WHEREAS the Provincial Board of Health has recommended the construction of Sanitary Sewers on certain streets in the City of North Bay according as such are shown in Schedule "A" hereto attached and which forms part of this By-law as a local improvement and it is, therefore, necessary and desirable in the public interest on sanitary grounds to construct such sewer according to such recommendation.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Sanitary Sewers be constructed on certain streets in the City of North Bay as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached and which forms part of this By-law as a local improvement under the Provisions of the Local Improvement Act together with all such necessary private drain connections to the line of the street connecting such sewers.
2. THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
3. THAT such work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence of and according to the instructions of such Engineer.
4. THE Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council as declared by a resolution.
5. THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the costs of the construction pending the completion of it.
6. The special assessment may be paid in 20 annual instalments.
7. The debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the costs of the work when completed shall bear interest at 5 per cent per annum and be made payable within 20 years on the instalment plan.
8. Any person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rates imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the costs of construction assessed upon such lot without interest forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified to by the Clerk.

SCHEDULE "A"

THIS IS SCHEDULE "A" referred to in By-law Number 895 of the City of North Bay authorizing the construction of sanitary sewers on certain streets in the City of North Bay.

1. On McIntyre Street from a point 220 feet Easterly from John Street to the West boundary of the Temiskaming and Northern Ontario Railway property on McIntyre Street.

2. On Gore Street from the center line of McIntyre Street south to the North Easterly boundary of the right of way of the Temiskaming and Northern Ontario Railway, a distance of 533 feet to connect with a sanitary sewer on the premises of the Temiskaming and Northern Ontario Railway Commission at the intersection of the North Easterly boundary of the said right of way and Gore Street.
