BY-LAW NO. 68-71

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE AN APPLICATION BEING MADE TO THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD TO CREATE AN URBAN SERVICE AREA AND TO AUTHORIZE THE IMPOSITION OF CERTAIN RATES UPON THE RATEABLE PROPERTY IN SUCH AREA.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay considers it expedient to create an Urban Service Area and to impose certain rates upon the rateable property within such area and to apply for an Order of the Ontario Municipal Board to create the same.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT the proper officers of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay are hereby authorized and directed to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board for an Order pursuant to the provisions of Section 14, Sub-section 10(c) of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 249, of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1960, as amended to date, creating the area described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and outlined in the plan attached as Schedule "B" an Urban Service Area and providing as follows:
 - (a) That mill rates may be levied annually on the UrbanService Area in an amount sufficient to recover:
 - (i) any capital cost of the water supply system
 not recovered through the collection of water
 rates on the water bill.
 - (ii) any capital cost not recovered through the collection of sewer rates on the water bill.
 (iii) the capital cost of storm sewers in the storm
 - drainage system.

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THIS by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof, subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.


THE PROPOSED URBAN AREA DESCRIPTION

Commencing at the point where the dividing line between the Township of Commanda and the City of North Bay intersects the shoreline of Lake Nipissing, thence, northerly along the said dividing line to its intersection with the dividing line between Concession "A" and "B" in the City of North Bay; thence, easterly along the said dividing line to its intersection with the dividing line between Lots 22 and 23 in Concession "B" in the said City. Thence, southerly, along the said dividing line between Lots 22 and 23 to its intersection with the dividing line between the north and south halves of Concession "B" in the said City. Thence, easterly along the said dividing line between the north and south halves of Concession "B" to its intersection with a line drawn parallel to and distant 500 feet west of the westerly limit of Lot 17, Concession "B" in the said City. Thence, northerly along the said line to its intersection with the line drawn parallel to and distant 500 feet northerly from the Airport Road. Thence, northeasterly along the said line to its point of intersection with the dividing line between Lots 18 and 19 in Concession "B". Thence, northerly along the said dividing line between Lots 18 and 19 to its intersection with the dividing line between Concession "A" and "B" in the said City. Thence, easterly along the said dividing line between Concessions "A" and "B" to its intersection with the dividing line between Lots 17 and 18 in Concession "B". Thence, south along the said dividing line between Lots 17 and 18 in Concession "B" to its intersection with the dividing line between Concession "B" and "C" in the said City. Thence, easterly along the said dividing line between Concessions "B" and "C" to its intersection with the dividing line between Lots 15 and 16 in Concession "C". Thence, south along the said dividing line between Lots 15 and 16 to its intersection with the shoreline of Trout Lake. Thence, south and easterly along the shoreline of Trout Lake to its intersection with the dividing line between Lots 14 and 15, Concession "C" in the said City.

Thence, southerly along the said dividing line between Lots 14 and 15 to its intersection with a line drawn parallel to and 500 feet south of the dividing line between Concession "C" and "D" in the said City. Thence, westerly along the said line to the intersection with the dividing line between Lots 16 and 17 in Concessions "C" and "D" of the said City. Thence, southerly along the said dividing line between Lots 16 and 17 to the point where the said line intersects the dividing line between the former Township of Widdifield and the former Township of West Ferris and being the northerly limit of Concession 18 of the former Township of West Ferris. Thence, southerly and westerly along the said north limit of Concession 18 to the east limit of the Canadian Pacific Railway line. Thence, southeasterly along the said east limit to the railway line to its intersection with the dividing line between Concessions 16 and 17. Thence, southwesterly along the said dividing line between Concessions 16 and 17 to its intersection with the dividing line between Lots 37 and 38 in Concession 16. Thence, southeasterly along the said dividing line between Lots 37 and 38 to its intersection with the dividing line between Concessions 15 and 16. Thence southwesterly along the said dividing line between Concessions 15 and 16 to its intersection with the dividing line with Lots 38 and 39.

Thence, southeasterly along the said dividing line between Lots 38 and 39 to its intersection with the line drawn parallel to and distant 500 feet north of Highway 11B. Thence, southerly and easterly along the said line parallel to Highway, to its intersection with the dividing line between Lots 36 and 37. Thence, southeasterly along the said dividing line between Lots 36 and 37 to the north limit of LaVase River. Thence, southerly and westerly along the said north limit of LaVase River to the shoreline of Lake Nipissing. Thence, northerly and westerly along the shoreline of Lake Nipissing to the point of commencement.


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III. the capital cost of storm sewers in the storm drainage system,

is hereby established.
