THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT R.S.O. 1960 CHAPTER 249 SECTION 286 SUBSECTION 3(g), HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT capital funds in the sum of \$13,205.00 be provided during the year 1967 for the Department of Parks and Recreation of the City of North Bay for permanent improvements to parks and playgrounds in the City of North Bay.
- THAT the Treasurer of The Corporation of the City of North Bay agree with any bank to borrow the aforesaid sum of \$13,205.00 by way of a term promissory note for a period of not more than five years bearing interest at the rate of not more than six and one-half per cent $(6\frac{1}{2}\%)$ per annum payable in equal annual instalments of principal and interest on the thirtieth day of June in each year commencing with the year 1968.
- 3. THIS By-law shall take effect upon the final passing thereof and upon receiving the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.


