BY-LAW NO. 1108

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law No. 1091 appointing John Small as Tax Collector and Water Commissioner in reference to the Commissions to be paid and the monthly allowance to be paid throughout the year.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend By-Law No. 1091 appointing John Small as Tax Collector and Water Commissioner in certain particulars regarding the Commissions to be paid for his services during 1933.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. THAT enacting paragraphs five and six (5 & 6) be and the same are hereby repealed.
- 2. THAT said paragraphs No's five and six (5 & 6) so repealed be replaced to read as follows:-
- (5) That the said Tax Collector and Water Commissioner shall be paid for the faithful performance of his duties for the year 1933 one percent. (1%) on all monies collected on taxes, water rates and interest thereon up to Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) and one-twelfth (1/12) of One per cent. on all monies collected for taxes, water rates and interest thereon over and above the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) excepting the collection of hydrant rentals and all other Municipal services with a guarantee of \$2,100.00) Twenty-one Hundred Dollars net remuneration for the year.
- (6) That in order to equalize the monthly payments the said Tax Collector and Water Commissioner be paid the sum of One Hundred and Seventy-five Dollars (\$175.00) per month and charged to his account with the balance, if any, payable on December 31st of the year.
- 3. This By-Law to be effective from the First day of January, 1933.

Read a First time in Open Council this 3rd day of April, 1933. Read a Second time in Open Council this 3rd day of April, 1933. Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 3rd day of April, 1933.
