BY-LAW NO. 129-88

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE MEMORIAL DRIVE FROM REGINA STREET TO THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE BOAT LAUNCHING RAMP.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Nipissing Progressive Conservation Association it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Memorial Drive pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 208, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the portion of Memorial Drive from Regina Street to the access road to the Boat Launching Ramp in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 8:30 o'clock in the forenoon until 10:00 o'clock in the evening on Sunday, the 4th day of September 1988 for the purpose of a Picnic.
- 2. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- 3. That prior to 11:00 o'clock in the evening on the 4th day of September 1988 the Nipissing Progressive Conservative Association will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Main Street to its condition prior to the above closure.
