## BY-LAW NO. 987

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to repeal By-Law No. 967 passed on the 7th day of July, 1930.

WHEREAS By-Law No. 967 of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay was passed on the 7th day of July 1930 to provide for the borrowing of Two Hundred and Eighty-Five thousand dollars (\$285,000.00) to pay for the construction of a vocational school in conjunction with the present Collegiate Institute.

AND WHEREAS it is requisite that this By-Law be repealed to provide for the passing of a subsequent By-Law in respect of the same matter.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT By-Law No. 967, passed by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay on the 7th day of July 1930, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Read a First time in Open Council this 15th day of December, 1930. Read a Second time in Open Council this 15th day of December, 1930. Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 15th day of December, 1930.
