## BY-LAW NO. 1657

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to amend By-law No. 1619, a by-law regulating traffic in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to amend said By-law 1619.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Clause No. 1 of By-law No. 1619 be amended by adding the following:

"Such Medical Profession privilege shall be in effect only between the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily, except Sundays."

So that Clause No. 1 of By-law No. 1619 shall now read as follows:

"That Section 39A By-law 1570 a By-law amending By-law 1464 be repealed and substituted with the following new section, as Section 39B.

'SECTION 39B: Medical Doctors, Members of the North Bay Medical Association.

That Sections 31 and 32 of By-law 1464 shall not apply to Passenger Motor Vehicles of the aforementioned Medical Doctors, provided the owner of such Passenger Motor Vehicle has applied and paid for Parking privileges at the annual rate of \$30.00 per year for a one car parking space. The Chief Constable to allocate the private parking space for such Medical Doctors. That all such spaces when allocated be clearly marked Medical Profession Private Parking and numbered to agree with each paid application. That such Medical Profession privilege shall be in effect only between the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily, except Sundays."

2. That this by-law shall become effective immediately upon the passing thereof.
