

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 158-81

BEING A BY-LAW TO ACQUIRE LANDS FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 193 provides that the Council may pass by-laws for acquiring land for the purposes of the Corporation.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized and directed to acquire from June Jaffray that Part of Lot 54, Plan M-355 in the City of North Bay designated as Part 2 according to Plan 36R-5775 and to pay the sum of \$3,500.00 therefor.
2. That the City Engineer is hereby directed that on completion of the Marshall Avenue widening for which the above lands are being acquired, the existing fence on the above lands will be relocated in the same or better form and the drainage problem caused by the installation of a Bell manhole on or about the subject lands will be corrected by the realignment of the ditch.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 19th DAY OF October , 1981.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 19th DAY OF October , 1981.
