## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 2000-10

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A TAX EXTENSION AGREEMENT (Marc Alexander Buckler - 102 Worthington Street West, North Bay)

WHEREAS Section 8 of the *Municipal Tax Sales Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-60 authorizes the municipality to pass a By-Law prior to the expiry of the redemption period to authorize an Extension Agreement for real property tax arrears;

AND WHEREAS the Treasurer has recommended this Tax Extension Agreement to Council for approval.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to enter into that certain agreement dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2000 between The Corporation of the City of North Bay and Marc Alexander Buckler (as the "Ratepayer") relating to the extension of a redemption period from month to month so long as a lump sum payment of \$3,000.00 and monthly payments of \$345.00 are made.
- The Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of North Bay are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2000 between The Corporation of the City of North Bay and Marc Alexander Buckler (the "Ratepayer") and to affix thereto the corporate seal, and such further and other agreements as may be reasonably required to give effect to this extension.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 7<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2000.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 7<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2000.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS  $7^{\text{TH}}$  DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2000.
