BY-LAW NO. 1673

BEING A BY-LAW to fix the annual fee to be paid for licenses for certain classes of trades and businesses within the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS by Resolution No. 34 passed at the regular meeting of City Council held Monday, February 18th 1952, adjustment in license rates was authorized for the year 1952, and that all by-laws inconsistent with this by-law be amended.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the following rates shall be in effect for the classifications as shown.

Tourist Homes, 1st room	5.00
each additional room	2.00
Tourist Cabins, each cabin	5.00

2. That all by-laws insofar as they are inconsistent with this By-law are repealed.
