BY-LAW NUMBER 1125

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to close a certain lane within the said City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay have been requested and upon consideration, deem it advisable to close the lane running from Rose Avenue to Lorne Avenue between McLeod and Morin Streets and to convey that lane upon its being closed up to Richard Whorley and Sheldon **C**. Clement of the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing, who are the owners of all of the lots from 31 to 60 inclusive abutting on the said lane.

THEREFORE under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay by the Municipal Act, being R.S.O. 1927, Chapter 233, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the lane running from Rose Avenue to Lorne Avenue between McLeod and Morin Streets, said lane being abutted by lots 31 to 60 inclusive according to plan M. 164 in the Lands Titles Office at the Cityof North Bay and as coloured Red on Plan hereto attached, be and the same is hereby closed and stopped up.

2. THAT forthwith upon this By-Law taking effect the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall convey the said lane as closed and stopped up under the next preceding section to Richard Whorley and Sheldon **C**. Clement for the consideration of the sum of $\frac{1}{2}$

3. THAT the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his or her Solicitor, Counsel or agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this By-Law, and who applies to be heard.

4. THAT this By-Law shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the Statutes in that behalf.

Read a First time in Open Council this 5th day of December, 1933. Read a Second time in Open Council this 5th day of December, 1933. Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 5th day of December, 1933.
