BY/LAW NUMBER 803

BEING A BY/LAW to prohibit the discharge of guns or other firearms in the City of North Bay, and to regulate the discharge of fire balls, squibs, crackers or fire works in the said City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to enact a Bylaw regulating the discharge of guns, or other firearms, and regulating the firing and setting off of fire balls, squibs, crackers or fireworks within the said City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPOR/ATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- (1) No guns, or other firearms are to be discharged within the limits of the City of North Bay.
- (2) No fireballs, squibs, crackers or fireworks are to be fired or set off in any place on Main Street, between Foran Street and Sherbrooke Street in the City of North Bay.
- (3) Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate a penalty not exceeding Ten Dollars (\$10.00), exclusive of costs for each offense, and in default of payment, the said penalty and costs, or costs only may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender or offenders and in case of there being no distress found out of which said penalty and costs, or costs only can be levied, the convicting Magistrate may commit the offender or offenders to the Common Gaol of the District of Nipissing, with or without hard labour for not exceeding Five Days unless the said penalty and cost, if any, or costs only including the costs of the said distress and of the committment and conveyance of the said offender or offenders to the said Gaol are seener paid.
