
B¥-LAW NO. 34-75

BEING A BY-LAW PASSED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL IMPROVEMENT ACT, R.S.O. 1970, CHAPTER 255, SECTION 8, DECLARING IT IS DESIRABLE THAT THE CON-STRUCTION OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, AS DESCRIBED IN SCHEDULE "A" TO THIS BY-LAW, SHOULD BE UNDERTAKEN AS A LOCAL IMPROVE-MENT.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY . OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of The Local Improvement Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 255, Section 8, it is hereby declared it is desirable that the construction of the concrete sidewalks on certain streets in the City of North Bay, as specified and described in Schedule "A" to this By-law, should be undertaken as a local improvement.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 24TH DAY OF MARCH, 1975. READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 24TH DAY OF MARCH, 1975. READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 24TH DAY OF MARCH, 1975.
