BY-LAW NUMBER 651

BEING a By-law to amond By-law number 318 of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay and to repeal By-law Number 561. 101

By-Law 65,

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of North Bay deem it advisable to amend By-law Number 318, and to repeal By-law Number 561, of the said Corporation.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS: -

1. That By-law Number 561 of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay be and the same is hereby repealed.

2. That sub-section five of section fourteen of By-law Number **318** shall now read as follows:-

"Mean frame structures covered with galvanized iron, corrugated or otherwise, or metallic siding.".

3. That sub-section six of section fourteen of By-law Number 318, be and the same is hereby repealed.

4. That section one hundred and fifteen of By-law Number 318, shall now read as follows:-

FIRE LIMITS

All those portions of the Town which are included within the following boundaries, shall constitute and be known as the fire limits, that is to say:

The Fire Limits of the Town of North Bay shall be divided into four districts known as Limit "A", Limit "B", Limit "C", and Limit "D".

LIMIT "A"

Buildings as classified 1 and 2 limited to C.P.R. property on South, Sherbrooke street on the East, McIntyre street on the North, and Cassells street on the West.

LIMIT "B"

Buildings as classified 1-2-3 or 4 outside of limits of Limit "A" bounded by Fisher, Worthington, Commercial, Klock Avenue, and Foren.

LIMIT "C"

Buildings as classified 1 to 5 outside limits of Limit "B" bounded by Second Avenue, Regina, Front to Klock to Jane to Murray to Main to Ninth street to C.P.R. property.

LIMIT "D"

Outside of Limit"C" any class of building may be erected here after plans have been approved by Inspector of Buildings.

Wherever any By-law or clause of any By-law conflicts with the terms of this By-law, such By-law or claus e of such By-law is hereby repealed and this By-law shall be considered to supersede such By-law or clause of such By-law.
