BEING A BY-LAW to reduce the salaries of the officials and employees of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS owing to the financial depression it is found necessary to reduce the salaries of all officials and employees of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. That all the salaries of the officials and employees of the City of North Bay ranging from and over the sum of ELEVEN HUNDRED (\$1100.00) DOLLARS and up to and including the sum of SIXTEEN HUNDRED (\$1600.00) DOLLARS per year be reduced by 5%.
2. That the salaries of all the officials and employees of the City of North Bay over SIXTEEN HUNDRED (\$1600.00) DOLLARS and up to and including the sum of TWENTY/ONE HUNDRED (\$2100.00) DOLLARS, per year be reduced by 10%.
3. That the salaries of all the officials and employees of the City of North Bay over TWENTY-ONE HUNDRED (\$2100.00) DOLLARS per year be reduced by 15%.
4. That those parts of By-Laws Nos. 820,842,884,886,897, 940,941,942,943 and any other By-Law or parts thereof inconsistent with these By-Laws are hereby repealed.
5. That this By-Law shall not apply to the salary of the Assessment Commissioner of the City of North Bay.

This By-Law shall go into effect immediately upon the passing thereof.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-Law was read a Third time short and passed this 7th day of March, 1932.
