BY-LAW NO. 1486

BEING a by-law of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to close part of Lavery Street in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay have been requested and upon consideration, deem it advisable to close part of Lavery Street in the said City of North Bay.

THEREFORE under and by virtue of the authority vested in the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay by the Municipal Act being R.S.O. 1937, Chapter 266, THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That part of Lavery Street in the City of North Bay, in the District of Nipissing described as follows;

ALL and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing and Province of Ontario being part of Lavery Street as shown on Plan by L. S. Clarke, O. L. S. and registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing on the 24th day of March, 1910, described as follows;

COMMENCING where the southerly boundary of Lavery Street intersects the Westerly boundary of Browning Street, thence westerly along the southerly boundary of Lavery Street a distance of 520 feeto a point where the southerly boundary of Beattie Street thence northerly along the easterly boundary of Beattie Street a distance of 66 feet to a point where the northerly boundary of Lavery Street intersects the said Easterly boundary of Beattie Street; thence easterly along the Northern Boundary of Lavery Street a distance of 520 feet to a point on the westerly boundary of Browning Street; thence southerly along the said westerly boundary of Browning Street a distance of 66 feet to the place of commencement.

BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY CLOSED AND STOPPED UP.

- 2. That forthwith on this by-law taking effect the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall convey the said part of Lavery Street as closed and stopped up in the next preceding section to the Civic Hospital Commission of the City of North Bay for the sum of ONE DOLLAR.
- 3. That the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay shall hear in person or by his or her Solicitor, Counsel or Agent, any person who claims that his or her lands will be prejudicially affected by this By-law, and who applies to be heard.
- 4. That this by-law shall take effect upon the passing thereof and after notice of the same has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks as provided by the Statutes in that behalf.
