

BY-LAW NO. 1596

BEING a By-Law to provide for the submission of certain Questions for the assent of the qualified electors of the City of North Bay and to appoint a day on which to take a vote thereon and to name the places where votes are to be taken and to appoint Deputy Returning Officers to take the Vote at each such place.

WHEREAS the said Council deems it advisable to submit to the vote of the electors of the Corporation, the following questions:

- (a) Are you in favour of allowing Circuses, Midways and Travelling Side Shows to operate within the Municipality?
- (b) Are you favour of public Games and sports on the Lord's Day to be regulated by Municipal By-Law under the authority of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act 1950?

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) That there shall be submitted to the electors of the City of North Bay:

- (a) Are you in favour of allowing Circuses, Midways and Travelling Side Shows to operate within the Municipality?
- (b) Are you in favour of public Games and sports on the Lord's Day to be regulated by Municipal By-Law under the authority of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act 1950?

(2) That the vote of the said Electors shall be taken on the said Questions at the same time and places and by the Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks, as the Annual Municipal Elections.

(3) That a true copy of the Questions shall be published in the North Bay Nugget on the days hereinafter mentioned, that is to say on the Eighth, Fifteenth and Twenty-Second days of November 1950.

(4) On the 29th day of November at his office in the Council Chambers, on Ferguson Street, in the City of North Bay at 2 o'clock in the afternoon the Mayor will in writing signed by him appoint two persons to attend the Final Summing up of the votes by the Clerk of this Corporation, and one person to attend each Polling Place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the proposed Money By-Laws, and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of opposing the Money By-Laws.

(5) The Thirteenth day of December at the said Council Chambers at 12 O'clock in the forenoon is hereby appointed as the time and place for summing up by the Clerk of this Corporation of the number of Votes given in the affirmative and in the negative, respectively.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 30th DAY OF OCTOBER 1950.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 30th DAY OF OCTOBER 1950.

RULES OF ORDER BE SUSPENDED AND BY-LAW READ A THIRD TIME SHORT AND PASSED THIS 30th DAY OF OCTOBER 1950.
