

BY-LAW NUMBER 1023

WHEREAS under By-Law Number 822 the City of North Bay is divided into five (5) wards with representation of Two (2) Aldermen from each Ward.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to repeal said By-Law Number 822. *Passed Dec 6<sup>th</sup> 1926*

AND WHEREAS it is provided under Subsection 2 of Section 46 of the Municipal Act, Revised Statutes of Ontario, Chapter 233 - in case where the Council of a City having a population of more than 15,000 by By-Law so provides the Aldermen shall be elected by general vote and the number of said Aldermen shall be the same as if they were elected by wards.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) That said By-Law Number 822 be and the same is hereby repealed.
- (2) That the Council of the City of North Bay shall be composed of the Mayor and Ten (10) Aldermen elected by general vote.

THIS BY-LAW shall go into effect if it receives the assent of the Municipal Electors of the City of North Bay on the 7th day of December, A. D. 1931, being the date of the Municipal Election for the said Municipal Council taking effect at and for the purpose of the annual election next after the passing of it.

 Read a Third time and passed in Open Council this 5th day of October, 1931.
