> A By-law to authorize the borrowing of $\$ 170,000$ upon debentures towards the cost of construction. of certain watermains in the City of North. Bay

```
WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay has passed construction By-law No. 93-72 authorizing the construction of watermans, including connections on:
1. King Street from Ferguson Street to Wyld Street
2. Wyld Street from King Street to First Avenue East
3. First Avenue East from Fisher Street to John Street
4. John Street from First Avenue East to Main Street East
AND WHEREAS for the purposes aforesaid it is now expedient to issue debentures in the amount of \(\$ 170,00\) payable in lawful money of Canada on the terms hereinafter set forth;
NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
1. For the purposes aforesaid, there shall be borrowed upon "the credit of the Corporation at large the sum of \$170,000 in lawful money of Canada, and the Cornoration shall issue debentures therefor in denominations of not less than \(\$ 50\) each.
```

2. The debentures shall be dated the 30 th day of November, 1973, shall be issued at one time and shall be pay ble in twenty annual instalments of principal on the 30 th of November in each of the years 1974 to 1993 , both inclusive, and shall bear interest payable semi-annualiy. The debentures maturing in the years 1974 to 1983, both inclusive, shall bear interest at the rate of eight and one-half percent ner annum, nd the debentures maturing in the years 1984 to 1993, both inclusive, shall bear interest at the rate of eight nd three-quarters percent per annum. The debentures shall have coupons attached for the payment of such interest on May 31 and November 30 in each year. The respective amounts of orincipal and interest payable in each of such years shall be as set forth in Schedule "A" hereto annexed and forming part of this by-law.
3. The debentures shill be payable as to both principal and interest in lawful money of Canada at the principal office of The Royal Bank of Canada in any of the cities of North Bay, Toronto or Montreal, at the holder's option.
4. The debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the Corporation and signed by the Mayor of the Corporation or by some other person authorized by by-law to sign them and by the Treasurer, and the interest coupons shall be signed by the Treasurer. The signature of the Mayor to the debentures, the signature of the Treasurer on the interest coupons and, if such debentures are countersigned in writing, by the Deputy Treasurer, the signature of the Treasurer to the debentures may be written or engraved, lithographed, printed or otherwise mechanically reproduced.
5. Commencing in the year 1974, and thereafter in each year during the currency of the said debentures, there shall be raised by a speci il rate sufficient therefor, over and above all other rates, on all the rateable property in the City of North Bay, the amount of the instalment of principal and interest payable in that year as set forth in Schedule "A" hereunto annexed, but no greater amount shall be raised than is required after taking into account receipts from any other source with respect to such works.
6. The debentures may contain any provision for their régistration authorized by law.
