And Whereas it was unanimously agreed among the eight other municipalities participating at the Cassellholme Board meeting on January 24, 2019 that this would be acceptable;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay direct Mayor Al McDonald to immediately write to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care, The Honourable Christine Elliott (copied to the Minister of Finance Victor Fedeli) asking that South Algonquin not be included in the amendments that are required to reconfigure the Board of Management for the District of Nipissing East (Schedule 4 of Ontario Regulation 79/10).

Therefore be It Resolved that the Council of the City of North Bay ask the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care to direct her officials to work with Cassellholme in order to obtain all of the government approvals that are necessary to proceed with the redevelopment and to do so as soon as is reasonably possible.

And Further that a copy of this Motion be sent to Minister of Finance, The Honourable Victor Fedeli, Minister of Health and Long Term Care, The Honourable Christine Elliott, and Jamie Lowery, Chief Executive Officer, Cassellholme.
