BY-LAW NO. 2007-169

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2005-03
(BEING A BY-LAW TO CONTROL THE USE OF
PESTICIDES IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY)**

WHEREAS the Council passed Resolution 2007-486 at its meeting held Monday, July 9, 2007, authorizing an amendment to By-law No. 2005-03 to include an exemption to permit the application of a pesticide product to ensure the safety of the public, or employees of a company, or to reduce the potential for fire risks at critical infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS;

1. That Section 3(a) of By-law No. 2005-03 shall be amended to include the following:

"3.(a) (xii) for the purpose of applying a pesticide product to ensure the safety of the public, or employees of a company, or to reduce the potential for fire risks at critical infrastructure."

2. That Schedule "A" of By-law No. 2005-03 shall be amended to include the following in the Action/Threshold Section for Class C Sites:

"Or in the presence of vegetation in confined areas that need to be maintained clear of vegetation for safety reasons."

3. That Schedule "A" of By-law No. 2005-03 shall be amended to include the following in the Limitations Column for Class C Sites:


"Pesticide may be used as a spot spray on infested area only and only in the interest of public or worker safety."

4. This by-law shall come into effect upon being passed.


READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 7TH DAY OF AUGUST, 2007.
