BY-LAW NO. 1861:

1861

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law No. 1820 a By-law to authorize construction of sanitary sewers, concrete sidewalks, asphalt road surfaces, and opening and gravelling of streets in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to amend said by-law No. 1820 be deleting from Schedule "A" thereof items number 8 and 23, under the provisions of Section 18, Champte 215, R.S.O. 1950, the Local Improvement Act.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOR TH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. That Schedule "A" of By-law No. 1820, a By-law to authorize construction of sanitary sewers, concrete sidewalks, asphalt road surfaces and opening and gravelling of streets in the City of North Bay, be amended by deleting therefrom items 8 and 23 as hereinafter described.
 - (a) Item 8, Schedule "A", being a 28' wide asphalt road surface on Ferguson Street between King and Victoria Street at an estimated cost of \$5,229.36.
 - (b) Item 23, Schedule "A", being a 24' wide asphalt road surface on Victoria Street between Fraser and Ferguson Street at an estimated cost of \$7,138.56.
- 2. That the total cost of works approved under By-law No. 1820 be thereby reduced to \$242,645.15.
- 3. That this By-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board.
