## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 100-90

BEING A BY-LAW TO IMPOSE, LEVY AND COLLECT TAXES FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 1990 FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to levy on the whole rateable property, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of The Corporation of the City of North Bay, a sum of money for educational purposes of the said City for the current year.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT, R.S.O. 1980, CHAP. 302, THE ASSESSMENT ACT, R.S.O. 1980 AND THE EDUCATION ACT, R.S.O. 1980, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. For the purpose of providing the sum of \$9,024,293. for the Public Elementary School purposes of The Corporation of the City of North Bay for the current year, there is hereby rated, levied and imposed a rate of 119.04 mills on the dollar upon the assessment for the Commercial and Industrial rateable property of the Public School supporters and 101.18 mills on the dollar upon the Residential rateable property of the Public School supporters, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the City of North Bay.
- 2. For the purpose of providing the sum of \$7,732,784. for Public Secondary School purposes of The Corporation of the City of North Bay for the current year, there is hereby rated, levied and imposed a rate of 99.01 mills on the dollar upon the assessment for the Commercial and Industrial rateable property of the Public School supporters, and 84.16 mills on the dollar upon the assessment for the Residential rateable property of the Public School supporters, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the City of North Bay.
- 3. For the purposes of providing the sum of \$3,389,933. for Separate Elementary School purposes of The Corporation of the City of North Bay for the current year, there is hereby rated, levied and imposed a rate of 117.66 mills on the dollar upon the assessment for the Commercial and Industrial rateable property of the Separate School Supporters, and 100.01 mills on the dollar upon the assessment for the Residential rateable property of the Separate School supporters, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the City of North Bay.
- 4. For the purposes of providing the sum of \$2,907,856. for Separate Secondary School purposes of The Corporation of the City of North Bay for the current year, there is hereby rated, levied and imposed a rate of 97.75 mills on the dollar upon the assessment for the Commercial and Industrial rateable property of the Separate School supporters, and 83.09 mills on the dollar upon the assessment for the Residential rateable property of the Separate School supporters, according to the last revised Assessment Roll of the City of North Bay.
- 5. Business taxes shall be levied on the whole of the assessment for business assessment according to the last revised Assessment Roll in the City of North Bay in accordance with the provisions of Section 158 of the Municipal Act aforesaid.

- The amounts required to be raised by this By-Law, pursuant to the 6. provisions of Section 158 of the Municipal Act aforesaid, shall be reduced by the amounts levied by interim tax levy as authorized by By-Law No. 14-90 of The City of North Bay.
- Real property taxes, rated and imposed, pursuant to the provisions 7. of this By-Law, shall become due and payable in three equal installments, namely, June 29, 1990, August 30, 1990 and October 30, 1990.
- Business taxes rated and imposed, pursuant to the provisions of this By-Law, shall become due and payable in one installment, 8. namely on June 29, 1990.
- 9. The Tax Collector and the Treasurer of The Corporation of the City of North Bay are hereby authorized and directed to mail or cause to be mailed to the address of the residence or place of business of each person taxed a notice specifying the amount of taxes payable by such person pursuant to the provisions of this By-Law.
- The aforesaid installments of Real Property taxes and the 10. aforesaid business taxes shall be paid into the office of the Treasurer, or the Tax Collector for The Corporation of the City of North Bay, on or before the respective due dates hereinbefore set forth.
- The Tax Collector and City Treasurer are hereby authorized to accept part payment from time to time on account of taxes as 11. aforesaid, which have become due, and to give a receipt for such part payment shall not affect the collection of any percentage charge imposed and collectable under By-law No. 18-83, in respect of non-payment of any taxes or classes of taxes or of any installment thereof.
- 12. In default of payment of the full amount of Business Taxes or of any installment of Real Property Taxes levied herein by the required due date for the payment thereof, the subsequent installment or installments thereof shall forthwith become due and **payable** and in addition thereto, a percentage charge of one and **one** quarter per cent (1 1/4%) is hereby imposed as a penalty for non-payment of such taxes or any installment thereof and such penalty shall be added to any taxes as aforesaid or any installment or part thereof remaining unpaid on the first day of each calender month thereafter in which default continues, but not after December 31, 1990.
- In default of payment of the full amount of any installment of Real Property taxes by the respective due date for the payment 13. thereof, as hereinbefore set forth, the subsequent installment or installments thereof shall forthwith become due and payable.
- 14. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the Tax Collector from proceeding at any time with the collection of any rate, tax or assessment or any part thereof, in accordance with the provisions of the Statues and By-Laws governing the collection of taxes.
- The Collector's Rolls for the year 1990 shall be prepared, certified and delivered by the City Clerk to the Tax Collector 15. pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Statues in that behalf.
