

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 95-71

BEING A BY-LAW TO LEVY AN ANNUAL TAX UPON LAURENTIAN UNIVERSITY.


WHEREAS Section 294b(1) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, as amended, permits the council of a local municipality designated by the Lieutenant Governor in Council to pass by-laws levying an annual tax upon a university designated by the Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS Ontario Regulations 333-70 and 334-70 so designate The Corporation of the City of North Bay and Laurentian University, respectively;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In the year 1971 and in each succeeding year there shall be levied on Laurentian University an annual tax not exceeding twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for each full-time student enrolled therewith.
2. In this By-law a "full-time student" shall mean a full-time student enrolled with Laurentian University on the first day of December in the year preceding the year of levy as determined by the Minister of University Affairs.
3. For the year 1971, the tax shall be at the rate of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per full-time student.
