THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 95-71

BEING A BY-LAW TO LEVY AN ANNUAL TAX UPON LAURENTIAN UNIVERSITY.

WHEREAS Section 294b(1) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, as amended, permits the council of a local municipality designated by the Lieutenant governor in Council to pass by-laws levying an annual tax upon a university designated by the Lieutenant Governor in Council;

AND WHEREAS Ontario Regulations 333-70 and 334-70 so designate The Corporation of the City of North Bay and Laurentian University, respectively;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. In the year 1971 and in each succeeding year there shall be levied on Laurentian University an annual tax not exceeding twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for each fulltime student enrolled therewith.
- 2. In this By-law a "full-time student" shall mean a fulltime student enrolled with Laurentian University on the first day of December in the year preceding the year of levy as determined by the Minister of University Affairs.
- 3. For the year 1971, the tax shall be at the rate of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per full-time student.
