

BY-LAW NO. 1628


BEING a By-law of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to designate Officials who will, for the purposes of executing documents on behalf of the Corporation of the City of North Bay relative to Contracts, Agreements, Deeds, Easements, Options, Banking and Financing, be the Official Signing Officers.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable and necessary under certain Statutes that such authorized Signing Officials be designated by By-law.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT signing officers, for the purpose of executing documents on behalf of the Corporation of the City of North Bay relative to Contracts, Agreements, deeds, Easements, Options, Banking, Financing and such other matter as may from time to time require signatures on behalf of the Corporation, be named.
2. THAT the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer be and are hereby designated as the Official Signing Officers of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.
3. THAT this By-law shall come into full force and effect immediately on the date of final passing thereof.
