BY-LAW NO. 1726

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide for the repealing of By-law No. 1610, a by-law providing for the levying of 1 mill upon the total taxable assessment of the municipality for the purpose of making a grant towards recreation to the Community Recreational Council.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay has received official information that such a by-law as By-law No: 1610 is not a mandatory by-law, and is not therefore binding upon Councils to provide for such a grant, and

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to repeal by-law No. 1610.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That By-law No. 1610 be and the same is hereby repealed.
- 2. That this By-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of final passing thereof.
