

BEING a By-Law to fix the Polling Places, appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the holding of Municipal Elections for the year 1924.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-Law fixing Polling Places and appointing Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the purpose of taking the vote of the Electors, to select a Mayor and Nine (9) Councillors to transact the Municipal affairs of the Town; for the selection of Public School Trustees, and for the approval or rejection of the By-Laws herein after mentioned:-

- (1) By-Law regarding the adoption of the Parks Act in the Town of North Bay.
- (2) By-Law regarding the proposed purchase, from Mrs. Ferguson, of a Park Site.
- (3) By-Law for the proposed improvement and extension of the Water Works System.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of North Bay enacts as follows:-

1. That Polling Place No. 1, for the purpose of said election shall be in Mr. W. Santry's Store, No. 384 Main St. West., and A. H. Hansman and W. E. Jackson are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers, and E. McCool and E. Loney are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.
2. That Polling Place No. 2, for the purpose of said election shall be in the Court House, Bye and McIntyre Streets, and B. Wickett and W. M. Flannery are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers, and ^{S.W. Willis} ~~R. S. Paterson~~ and L. McKeown are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.
3. That Polling Place No. 3, for the purpose of said election shall be in Jas. Pelangio's Store, No. 38 Front Street, and W. E. Hick and E. J. Labreche are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers, and Geo. Parker and Bert Lehman are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.
4. That Polling Place No. 4, for the purpose of said election shall be in Ontario Forestry Office, Corner McIntyre St. and Klock Avenue, and W. L. Bishop and N. Phelps are hereby appointed Deputy

Returning Officers and D. F. Connell and L. Dreany are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.

5. That Polling Place No. 5, for the purpose of said election shall be in the Town Hall, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets, and J. J. Doucett and T. H. Winters are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers and R. D. Campbell and J. Billington are Hereby appointed Poll Clerks.

6. That Polling Place No. 6, for the purpose of said election shall be in the G. W. V.A. Club Rooms, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets, and J. E. Lehman and T. N. Colgan are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers and Chas. Harrison and W. D. Childerhose are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.

7. That Polling Place No. 7, for the purpose of said election shall be in the Orange Hall, Fisher and McIntyre Streets, and A. O. Laing and Geo. Morgan are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers and G. Darling and Don. Smith are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.

8, That Polling Place No. 8, for the purpose of said election shall be in E. A. Tilley's House, No. 239 McIntyre St. East, and J. W. Sewell and R. Colbon are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers and C. Edey and H. R. Miller are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.

9. That Polling Place No. 9, for the purpose of said election shall be in E. M. Quirt's Store, 327 Main Street E., and R. S. Putnam are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers and Walter Jones ~~is~~ ^{an} hereby appointed Poll Clerks

10. That Polling Place No. 10, for the purpose of said election shall be in Taylor's Store, Corner Fifth Avenue and Fisher Street, and L. R. Hume and W. H. Colyer are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers and G. K. Newton and ~~S.~~ ^{G. H.} ~~W. H.~~ ^{Bunyan} are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.

11. That Polling Place No. 11, for the purpose of said election shall be in Quinlan's Office, Percy and Cassells Streets, and J. J. Pratt and J. Lethbridge are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers and R. J. Ellis ^{and H. Fodal} is hereby appointed Poll Clerk.

12. That Polling Place No. 12, for the purpose of said election shall be in Antonio Lucenti's House, No. 129 Front Street, and W. F. Roynon and E. Everitt are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers and V. B. Wilcock and Don. Anderson are hereby appointed Poll Clerks.

13. That Polling Place No. 13, for the purpose of said election shall be in E. C. Bebee's Store, Cassells and Third Streets, and E. C. Bebee is hereby appointed Deputy returning Officer and Alvin Miller is hereby appointed Poll Clerk.

14. That the Railway Employees' Advance Polling Place for the purpose of the said election shall be in the Town Hall, Ferguson and McIntyre Streets, and A. C. Amos is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
