Under the direction of the Roads Supervisor, operates utility tractor with various attachments to perform seasonal duties such as grass cutting, sweeping roads, bike lanes and sidewalks, trimming brush, pothole patching, addressing shoulder drop offs, traffic control, and assisting with roads operating tasks and ditching. Completes minor tractor and equipment maintenance and performs various labourer duties.

The successful candidate will possess the following requirements:

- Grade 10 education or equivalent acceptable experience.
- Six (6) months experience in the operation of a utility tractor.
- Demonstrated ability in the operation of a skidsteer.
- Must be able to take instructions and carry them out without supervision.
