

BY-LAW NO. 1704.

BEING A By-Law of the City of North Bay to appoint a Fire Chief.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-Law to provide for the appointment of a Fire Chief for the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Frederick Charles Strange be named and is hereby appointed Fire Chief for the City of North Bay.
2. That Frederick Charles Strange promoted from the ranks of the Municipal Fire Department is to retain his seniority with the City of North Bay as a Fireman while serving as a Fire Chief.
3. That he be paid at the per annum salary of \$3,925.00 per year plus Consumers Price Bonus Payments according to the terms of the Consumers Price By-Law.
4. That annual increases granted to Firemen and Junior Officers of the Department will be made applicable to the Fire Chief as well.
5. That this appointment shall be effective as of November 15th, 1953.
6. That all other By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law are hereby repealed.
