# THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

### BY-LAW NO. 2008-135

#### BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1990-221 (A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF O.N.R. TRAIN WHISTLES AT LEVEL CROSSINGS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY)

**WHEREAS** Council passed Resolution No. 2008-325 at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, April 28, 2008 to amend By-law No. 1990-221 to prohibit the use of train whistles in the area of the pedestrian crossings at Johnston Road and Trout Lake Road;

**AND WHEREAS** the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission has advised that it intends to have the train engines slow to 15 mph and to ring their bells at the pedestrian crossings at Johnston Road and Trout Lake Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 1 of By-law No. 1990-221 is hereby deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof:
  - "1. (a) The sounding of any railway train engine whistle at the following highway crossings in the City of North Bay is hereby prohibited between the hours of 8:00 p.m. of one day and 8:00 a.m. of the next day:

1(b) The sounding of any railway train engine whistle at the following pedestrian crossings in the City of North Bay is hereby prohibited at all times:

#### TEMAGAMI SUBDIVISION

MILEAGE	PEDESTRIAN CROSSING
2.60	South crossing – Johnston Road
2.71	North crossing – Trout Lake Road."

2. This By-law comes into effect upon being passed.
