THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 90-94

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A PORTION OF MAIN STREET FROM FRASER TO FERGUSON STREETS AND FROM FERGUSON TO WYLD STREETS.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Main Street, from Fraser to Ferguson Streets and from Ferguson to Wyld Streets, pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, Section 207, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the portion of Main Street, from Fraser to Ferguson Streets and from Ferguson to Wyld Streets, in the City of North Bay, be and the same is hereby closed from 12 o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, 29 July, 1994, to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, 31 July, 1994, for the purpose of accommodating special promotional events planned by the Downtown Improvement Area for the Heritage Festival Weekend.
- 2. That the Director of Transportation and Works is hereby authorized to arrange to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- 3. That prior to 6:00 p.m. in the afternoon on the 31st day of July, 1994, the Director of Transportation and Works will arrange to the restoration of the said portion of Main Street to its conditions prior to the above closure.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 18TH DAY OF JULY, 1994.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 18TH DAY OF JULY, 1994.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 18TH DAY OF JULY, 1994.
