BY-LAW NO. 3-74

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 86-73 BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION OF STORM SEWERS ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AND TO IMPOSE A SPECIAL RATE.

WHEREAS by reason of a revised estimate, the cost of construction will be in excess of the amount set out in Schedule "A" to By-law No. 86-73 and approved by the Ontario Municipal Board by its Order dated 15 November, 1973;

AND WHEREAS by reason of no subsidy being available from the Ministry of Transportation and Communications for construction of the Storm Sewers set out in Schedule "A" to By-law No. 86-73.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Schedule "A" to By-law No. 86-73 be and is hereby replaced with Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
- 2. That this By-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board, pursuant to Section 64(1) of The Ontario Municipal Board Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 323.



THE BOARD ORDERS that the corporation may incur an additional expenditure of \$140,000.00 for completion of the construction of the storm sewers described or referred to in Item 1.(a), (b) and (c) set forth in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of the previous order of the Board made on the 15th day of November, 1973, and entered in order book No. E 73-5 at folio 51 on the 28th day of November, 1973 and for such purpose may pass all requisite by-laws, including by-laws providing for the issue of debentures in a principal amount not exceeding \$278,000.00 repayable within the term prescribed in the said previous order, and may borrow money to the extent sufficient to provide an amount not exceeding \$278,000.00 therefor, provided:

- 1. that the corporation may borrow the whole or any part of the said sum of \$140,000.00 as required pending receipt of subsidies and the sale of debentures or the receipt of moneys from any other source,
- 2. that the amount to be debentured shall not exceed in any event the net cost to the corporation after deducting any grant or contribution from the Province of Ontario or from any other source in respect of the said work, and
- 3. that no commitment shall be made nor work undertaken, unless and until the said corporation has ascertained that the work is of a nature that is eligible for subsidy toward the cost thereof at the applicable rate by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.
