BY-LAW NO. 1703.

BEING A BY-LAW to authorize construction of storm and sanitary sewers in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to provide for the construction of storm and sanitary sewers in the said City.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTHBAY under the Provisions of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1950, Chapter 243, Section 386, Sub-section 12, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS.

- 1. That storm and sanitary sewers be constructed on the streets de: scribed in Schedule A, which schedule is attached hereto and forms part of this by-law.
- 2. That the Consulting Engineer of the City be instructed to make all necessary plans, profiles and specifications forthwith, and to furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work, or for the carrying on of the work by day labour.
- 3. That the work shall be carried on under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of the Consulting Engineer of the City.
- 4. The Council may decide by Resolution to carry one and execute the work by day labour.
- 5. In the absence of a resolution by Council that the work be carried on and executed by day labour, the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with some person or persons, firm or corporation for the construction of the work, subject to the approval of the Council by resolution.
- 6. The Treasurer, may subject to approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending completion of such work.
- 7. That debentures to be issued when the work is completed to pay for the cost of such work, shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and shall be made payable within years on the instalment plan.
- 8. That this By-Law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 67, Sub-section 1, of the Ontario Municipal Board Act (R.S.O. 1950, Chapter 262).
