

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 128-81

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF LANDS  
NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS Section 193(1) of The Municipal Act R.S.O. 1980,  
Chapter 302 provides that the Council may pass by-laws for selling  
lands no longer required for municipal purposes.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF  
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay transfer  
and sell to Giovanni Severino all of Lots 7 and 8, Plan  
M-179 in the City of North Bay upon the receipt of the  
sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty (\$2,250.00)  
Dollars.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the  
City of North Bay be and they are hereby authorized  
to execute that certain Transfer to Giovanni Severino  
dated June 25th, 1981.
3. This by-law comes into force and effect upon being  
finally passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 27th DAY OF July  
1981.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 10th DAY OF August  
1981.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS
